The Plein Air Painters are going to have an exhibit in September at the International Museum of Art! Since we have a large amount of money in the account, we have reserved the month of Sept. for the show.

But don't panic! We have decided to make the show a sort of retrospective of the group. You can exhibit new work, of course, but you are also allowed to bring older work. If you have a favorite work that is hanging on your walls, bring that. Look through your unfinished work, finish them and bring them.

Each Artist may exhibit FOUR Pieces 11 X 14 and larger. Two smaller pieces (under 11 X 14) may replace a larger piece- 2 for 1. There will be a special section for the miniature paintings.

Work will be turned in at the International Museum on Wednesday, Sept 4, 2019 from 10 A.M. to 1 P.M. No Exceptions.

Please make two cards with the following info:

NAME OF ARTWORK, MEDIUM, PRICE & ARTIST and Artist phone number for sales.

Put one card on the back of the piece and give one to the person checking in the paintings to be used for the title cards.

RULES: Plein Air Painting requirement is “painting outside in the open” – 60% or more, and no more than 40% in studio”. No age limit of each piece, as the PLEIN AIR PAINTER'S OF EL PASO have been in existence since 1997.....Yes...22 years!
